ELIGIBILITY : Strictly as per M.D. University Rules

B.A./B.Com./B.S.W. & B.Sc. (Med./Non Med.)(Sem-I) (10 + 2 + 3 pattern)

No one shall be eligible to join the first semester of B.A./B.Com./B.S.W & B.Sc. unless she has passed one of the following examinations with at least 33% marks in aggregate for admission to B.A. Sem-I, 40% for admission to B.Com. Sem-I and 45% for admission to B.S.W. & B.Sc. Sem-I (minimum pass marks in case of SC/ST candidates) :

- a) Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10 + 2) of Haryana School Education Board, Bhiwani.
OR
- b) Diploma in Pharmacy Course (for B.A./B.Sc.-Sem-I only)
OR
- c) 3-Year professional diploma programmes conducted by the State Board of Technical Education Haryana without-passing English and Hindi subjects at 10 + 2 level for admission to B.A./B.Sc./B.com/B.S.W. courses.
OR
- d) Any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.
- e) **Candidates who have compartment/re-appear in one or more paper(s) in the qualifying examinations shall not be allowed admission in 1st semester of the course in any case.**

Guidelines & Rules for the Students

The College is affiliated to Maharishi Dayanand University Rohtak and ordinance of the university regarding admissions, Syllabi, Scheme of exams, results etc. will be applicable for all courses being run in the college.

1. The students are advised to select/ choose their subjects with utmost caution. In case of any mistake/ modification in the subject or in the admission form, college will not be responsible.
2. The students should be habitually clean and always come neatly and properly dressed. No shorts or skirts are allowed and students must come in uniform as prescribed by college on Monday and Tuesday.
3. All students are expected to keep their class-rooms and campus clean. Use dust-bin for leftovers. The students using college buses/ vehicles must maintain discipline and keep them clean. Any damage done by the students will be charged accordingly.

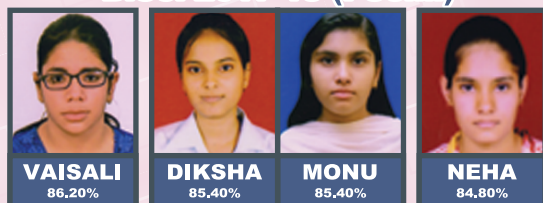

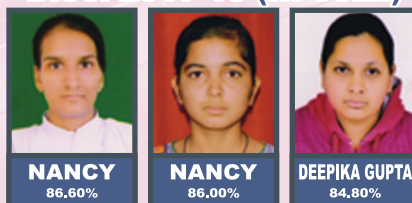

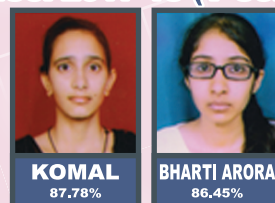
B.Sc. 2017-18 (I Sem.)



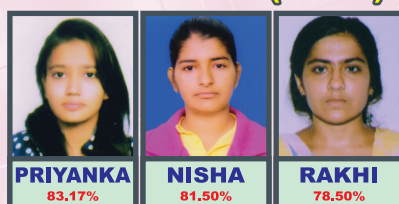
B.Sc. 2017-18 (III Sem.)



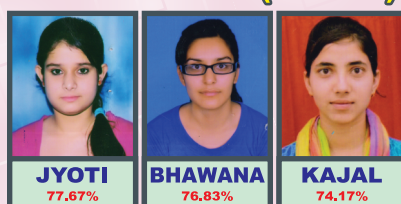

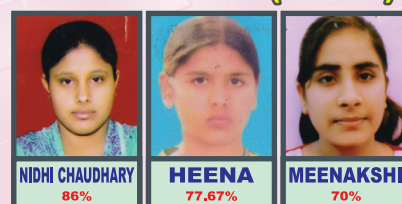

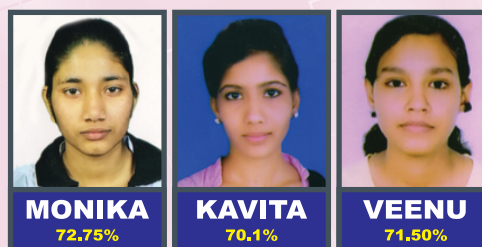
